## Thai course Application Guidelines

JISHA supports Safety and Health activities  
for Japanese affiliated companies in Asia



## Support Overview

JISHA conducts two kinds of incorporated supports : One is for 'OSH Basic Training in Japan' where experts of safety and health teach their know-how and experiences for preventing labor accidents, and the other is for 'Follow-up Training in Thailand' where OSH experts are dispatched to overseas bases to provide advice and guidance.

### (1) OSH Basic Training in Japan

JISHA aims to improve abilities of staff who are in charge of safety and health management in Japanese overseas affiliated companies by teaching not only practical activities at industrial sites in Japan, but also activities such as OSHMS (Occupational Safety and Health Management System), Risk Assessment, Zero-Accident Activities, Health Promotion Activities and 5S developed as company-wide activities..

### (2) Follow-up Training in Thailand

JISHA dispatches OSH experts to your workplace from Japan to support 'OSH Basic Training' and provide advice and guidance on safety and health for a few hours depending on the situation at job sites.

These days, the number of Japanese companies starting their operation in Asian region is prominently increasing. However, there are some cases where the lack of information and experiences leads to insufficient OSH in overseas bases of the companies.

Therefore, JISHA conducts this project in order to contribute to preventing labor accident as well as raising the safety awareness of the local employees by introducing know-how and experiences in OSH field, which have been built up in Japan for a long time, in safety and health activities of Japanese affiliated companies.

## ▶ Program

### (1) OSH Basic Training in Japan

JISHA holds OSH training courses in Thai languages in FY2022.

Courses in Thai language : Monday, December 5 ~ Saturday, December 10 (6 days)

Target company : Japanese affiliated company in Thailand

Training venue : JISHA (Tokyo)

Number of trainee admitted : Approx.10 people (Basically, 1 trainee per company, acceptable 2 trainees depending on the application status)

Application period : Friday, August 19, 2022

※The application will be closed as soon as the capacity is reached. Please note that it will be announced on the website.

### (2) Follow-up Training in Thailand

Experts will be dispatched sometime from February to March in 2023.

It will be held in the workplace of the local companies in Thailand that trainees who attended the abovementioned courses belong to. Time needed for advice and guidance will be a few hours for each job site..

※The schedule will be coordinated individually with the contact person in the parent company in Japan.

※Target companies should be near Bangkok and Chiang Mai (about 2 hours by car from the central city). Please contact us if your company is in other areas.

## ▶ Training requirements

Those who are eligible for trainings should belong to Japanese overseas affiliated of manufacturing industry, and fulfill all the following conditions from ① through ④.

- ① Those who are recommended by representatives of companies belonging to.
- ② Those who have more than three years of work experiences in safety and health
- ③ Those who have expertise in safety and health
- ④ Basically, those who are under 40 years old and are willing to continue working for the company they belong to even after participating in this project.

## ▶ Expenses

### (1) OSH Basic Training in Japan

Companies or a trainee herself / himself should bear such expenditures as trainee's round-trip travel expenses to Japan, hotel accommodations, charges for local travel and meal expenses in Japan. JISHA bears training fees.

### (2) Follow-up Training in Thailand

JISHA bears such expenditures as expert's round-trip travel expenses to Thailand, hotel accommodations, meal expenses, interpretation fees, and fees for advice and guidance. Basically, the companies bear no cost.

## ▶ How to apply

Please download the prescribed application at the following JISHA's website (<https://www.jisha.or.jp/international/co-ope/sakura.html>), and apply to JISHA via e-mail by the indicated deadline through department in charge of safety and health of parent companies in Japan of Japanese overseas affiliated companies where applicants belong to.

After the applications are accepted, qualified trainees will be selected on the basis of training requirements, and its result will be informed to the contact person of their parent company in Japan via e-mail etc. by early September. Please note that if there are many applicants, you may not be able to attend the project.
