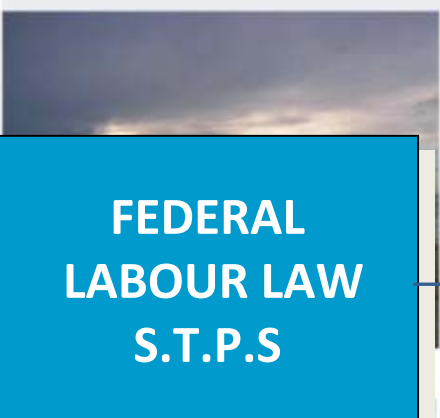

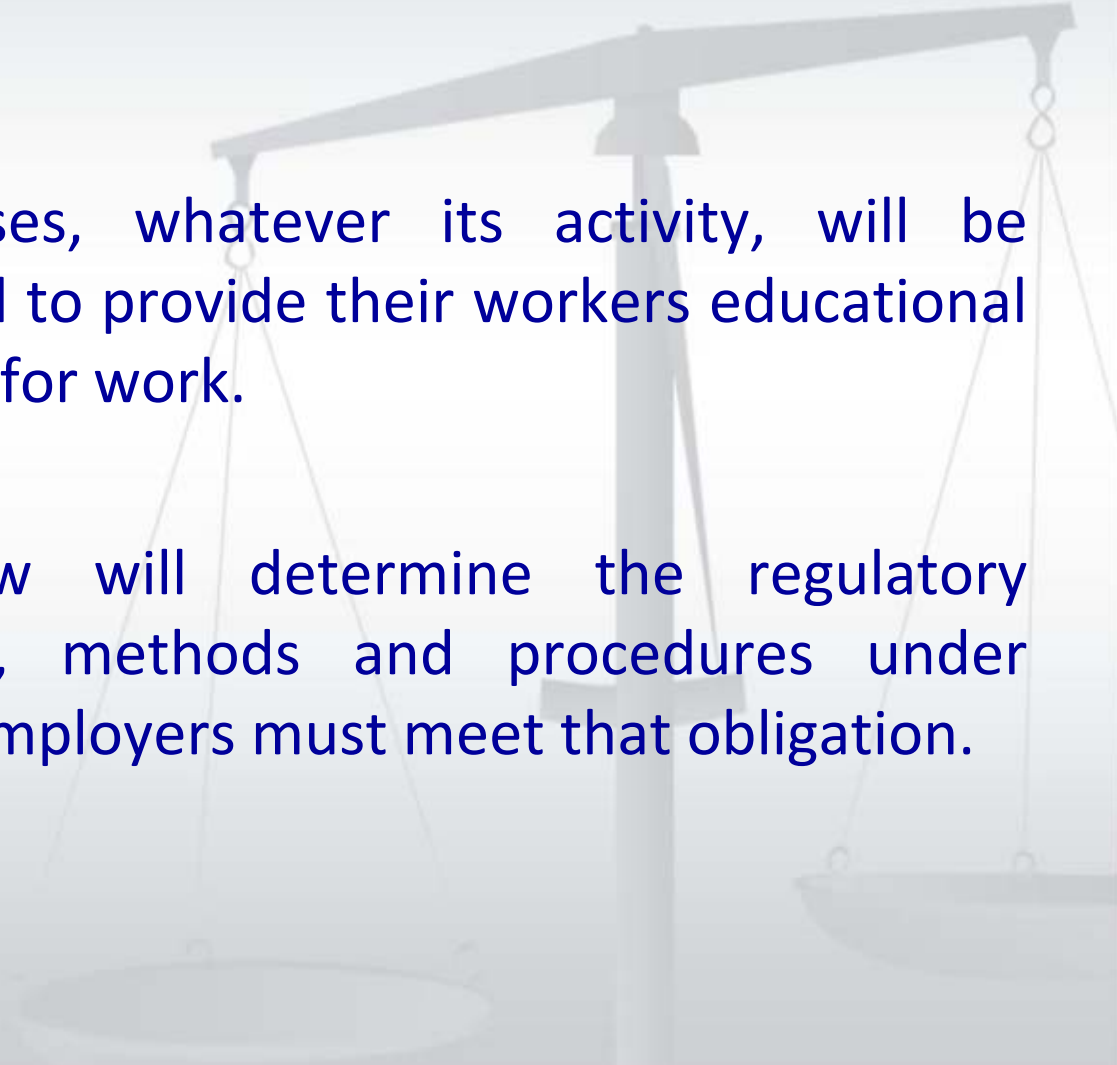

WHAT IS ABOUT?

➤ XIII

- Businesses, whatever its activity, will be required to provide their workers educational training for work.
- The law will determine the regulatory systems, methods and procedures under which employers must meet that obligation.



WHAT IS ABOUT?

➤ XIV

- Employers will be liable for accidents at work and occupational diseases, therefore employers must pay compensation. This responsibility shall continue even if the employer controls the work by an intermediary.



WHAT IS ABOUT?

➤ XV

- The employer is obliged to observe, in accordance with the regulations of their negotiation, the legal precepts on health and safety at the premises of their establishment and take appropriate measures to prevent accidents in the use of machines, tools and work materials, and to organize in such a way that, to make it the best guarantee for health, the lives of workers and the product of conception in the case of pregnant women. The laws include the effect of sanctions coming in each case





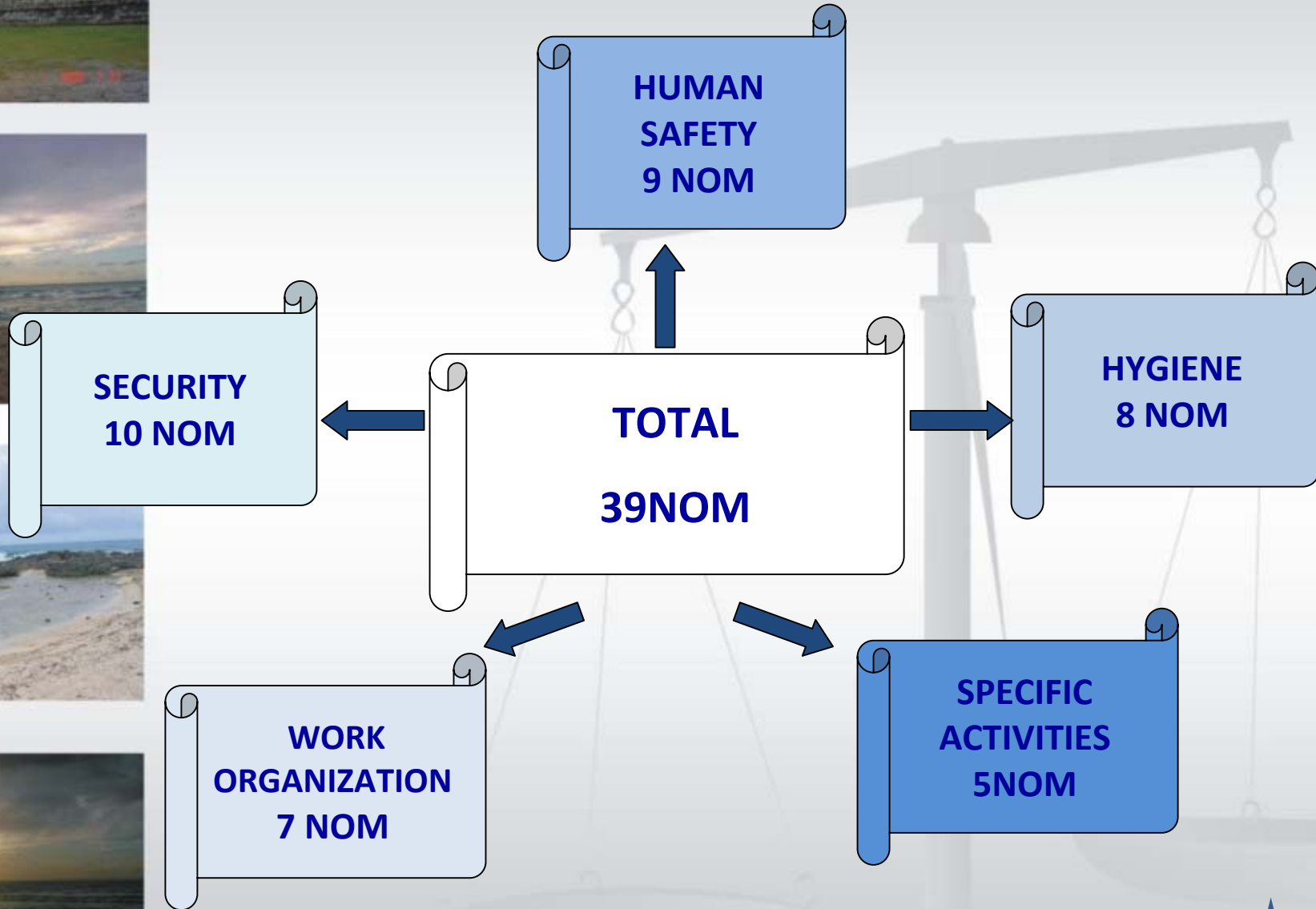
